Program Information:

First Taste Program

- Ages 3-5 (Pre-K, K)
- Sunday 9:00 AM - 11:30 AM

In this class, we capture your child's attention with Jewish song, art, and games. By exposure to the Aleph-Bet, Mitzvot, Prayer, and Holiday Studies, the children gain a sense of love and pride in Judaism.

Hebrew School

- 1st-4th Grade
- Sunday - 9:00am - 11:30am

This program offers a more intense Hebrew and Jewish studies curriculum. Students learn to read and write Hebrew, and gain an appreciation for the who, what, when, and why of Jewish life.

Tuition and Fees:

Registration fee: \$100.00 (due with registration form no later than August 13).

Tuition: \$650.00

Grand Total: \$750 (no other membership fees or Temple dues charged)

Payment Options:

Option 1: Prepayment in full before September 5, 2010.

Option 2: Pay 2/3 of tuition before September 5, 2010 & the remaining 1/3 of tuition no later than January 5, 2010.
